* We try to meet as a group once a quarter, but I have books available on a daily basis for LAB members to checkout and review.

*The majority of the books the LAB review are YA novels recommended by various committees from ALA (American Library Association) and other review sources I receive. Members of the LAB can also recommend books for others to review.

*The final decision to purchase any book recommend by the LAB lies with Mrs. Mitchell and the School Library Advisory Board.

*CAUTION- these would be books that I have not personally read, so there may be content which may not be appropriate for every student. That is part of goals of the Board – to find books which are appropriate and interesting for the SJMS students. If a student does run into such a situation, they may stop reading the book immediately, if they choose; this would not jeopardize their membership in the LAB.
