The Library Media Department at SUU offers all of the coursework necessary for the Library Media minor and the Utah Library Media Endorsement (both undergraduate and graduate). All courses are available on the Internet.

LM Minor



The Library Media minor is designed for those interested in libraries. It will not lead to public school endorsement.

Requirements and Coursework

The minor requires 17 credits of which nine credits must be taken from SUU. Older credit may be accepted.

LM Endorsement Undergraduate

The Library Media Endorsement provides the courses required for the Utah School Library Media License (K-12). The student must currently have, or be seeking, a valid Utah educator’s license.



Requirements and Coursework

The undergraduate endorsement requires 18 credits and must be completed during the six years prior to application for endorsement. Twelve credits must be taken through SUU.

Completion of the coursework and practicum does not automatically guarantee a recommendation by the department for state endorsement in Library Media. To be recommended for endorsement, a student must complete the program with a grade point average of 3.0 or higher and demonstrate competency in the coursework with potential to work effectively with both students and teachers. The student must also currently have a valid Utah educator’s license before being awarded final endorsement in Library Media.

LM Endorsement Graduate Studies

All candidates must have a Utah Elementary or Secondary Education degree and license. Candidates who have an educator’s license may complete this K-12 endorsement concurrently with the SUU M.Ed. program. Candidates with a bachelor’s degree may enroll in the undergraduate program.

Requirements and Coursework

Eighteen credits are required for graduate endorsement and must be completed during the six years prior to application for license. Twelve credits must be taken through SUU.

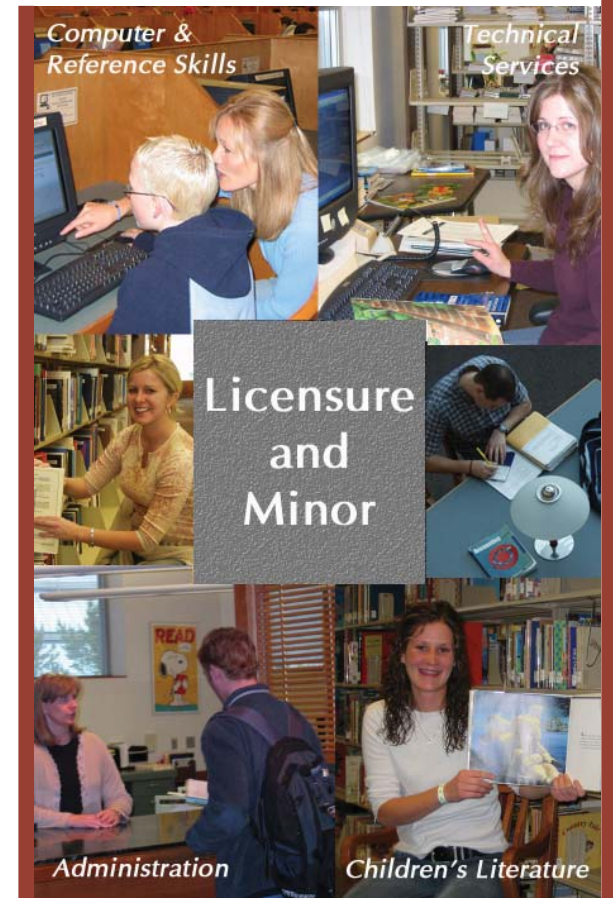
