The 2012 Utah Educational Library Media Association conference will be held Thursday, March 15th at Weber State University in the Shepherd Union building. We invite you to attend with your librarian or district media supervisor and enjoy a full venue of presentations.

Our conference theme this year will be "Building 21st century Skills Today For Tomorrow." Our keynote speaker, Dr. William A. Sederburg, Commissioner of the Utah System of Higher Education, will address the theme topic. Dr. Sederberg has announced his retirement, effective in August. He will provide valuable insight into the tasks facing Utah school librarians in preparing students for post secondary education.



We have a strong line-up of presenters on a variety of professional and practical topics. One session will have Bruce Lindsay, KSL News Anchor, presenting on storytelling. In addition we will have several authors presenting sessions and doing book signings. Authors include Amber Argyle, Ann Cannon, Brandon Mull, Carolyn Buenher, Joy Spraycar, Katy Rydell, and Dr. Mike Tunnell. The overall conference will be broken up into four presentation blocks of fifty minutes each and attendees will have eight to twelve presentations per block period to select from. The last presentation block will conclude at 3:10 p.m. which will give attendees plenty of time to visit with authors, vendors and friends.

It will be spring break at WSU and parking will be plentiful and close. A continental breakfast, buffet lunch and afternoon ice cream break will be provided.
